



Ready, Set, Go – Listen Up Part 4 – Greg Kennedy

INTRODUCTION:

Did God intend for hearing Him to be that difficult? What should we do if we feel like we have heard God? What should our response be? In this message Greg Kennedy answers these questions and uses the illustration of a stoplight to describe how God responds to our prayers. Hearing God was never meant to be difficult and it is the key to walking in the peace of God.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Why do you think hearing God is so difficult? Do you think God ever meant it to be difficult? How is disobedience the biggest hindrance to hearing God?
2. Read John 7:38. What is the innermost part of a man or woman? Why is keeping our heart and mind focused on God necessary in hearing Him? How does that help us have peace?
3. How does God use our spouses, parents, and mentors to speak to us? Why should we seek counsel for important decisions?
4. How is a stoplight an illustration of how God responds to our prayers to Him? What does it mean when God responds to us with a red light?
5. What does the yellow light illustrate in the way God responds to us? Why is it so important to stay connected to the voice of God even when He responds to us with a green light?

THINK ABOUT IT:

1. How is hearing God the secret to living in the fullness of life as God intended it? It's the secret to a long and happy relationship with God. God never meant it to be difficult to hear Him; in fact He's given us many ways. It takes us being willing to pay attention to His signals.

1. What steps can you take to better listen to and obey the voice of God?
